For pluggable equipment, the socket-outlet shall be installed near the equipment and shall be easily accessible.


Introduction

Diagram of ILC Series' Advanced Protection




Operating Instructions

- 1. Place the ILC unit near a grounded (3-pronged) 120V electrical outlet that is easily accessible. *Do not connect anything yet to the outlets on the ILC.* When you plug in the ILC's power cord into the outlet, power will be available at the outlets in the rear of the unit.
- 2. Plug in the equipment you want protected by the ILC into the AC outlets in the rear of the ILC. Make sure that your equipment is initially turned off, and that you don't exceed the maximum power rating of your ILC model.
- 3. Turn on your equipment one at a time. If you have exceeded the maximum power rating of your ILC, the rear circuit breaker will open after a short period of time. In such a case, reduce the load to your ILC and reset the circuit breaker. *Note: It may take about 30 seconds for the thermal circuit breaker to cool and become resettable.*
- 4. To turn off the ILC, unplug the ILC from the AC outlet.

Note

Some models may be equipped with only 2 output receptacles instead of 4 as shown above or may be equipped with 5-15R duplex receptacles.

Caution

Be sure to only plug in the ILC into a properly grounded (3-pronged), 120V electrical outlet. Use of an ungrounded outlet will not fully utilize the protection built into the ILC, and may risk electrical shock.
